Enable French and/or Francophone students to follow an **intensive in-depth training** with English as a language of instruction in Literature and Social Studies;

APPLICATION

Students will take an entrance test in May

Families who are interested should apply by completing the online form **from March 06 to April 14, 2023**



ORGANIZATION

CP to CE2 with an American teacher following the American curriculum

CM1 to CM2

with an American teacher following the American curriculum: 4h Language and Literature, 2h Social Studies

6ème to 3ème

3h in English language;

4h Literature and 2h Social Studies with an American teacher following the American curriculum

In each cycle, students will participate in joint projects.

OFFICIAL EXAMINATION

DNBI

Diplôme National du **Brevet International** In addition to the Diplôme National du Brevet (National Diploma), students will take two oral exams in Literature and Social Studies in order to obtain the DNBI.

BFI **Option Internationale** au Baccalauréat

Students enrolling in the American International Section will take the BFI in 2024, which grants them access to Higher education in France, USA and Canada.



All levels concerned except terminale (grade 12) Access limited: 24 places per level

Test for CP, CE1, CE2: oral test only

Test for other levels : oral and written tests

REQUIREMENTS

- WHO? Students who are fluent in both English and French
 - Students who show intellectual curiosity for the English and French languages and this related cultures
 - Students who are capable of coping with additional classes and who are willing to get involved in ambitious projects.

HOW?

- 1- Apply by completing the **ONLINE FORM** (on per student) and add an « Appraisal Form » filled by the teacher of your child (for the current school year).
- 2- Pay the required application fee :
 - * 30 000 fcfa per student (test on-site)
 - * 40 000 fcfa per student (distance testing only for CM et 1^{ère})

Please note that the application fee is non-refundable. Should your child pass the tests, a supplement to the standard tuition fee will be applied.

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
