ORGANIZATION

Cycle 2 - 4H with an American teacher following the American curriculum

Cycle 3 - 6H with an American teacher following the American curriculum :
4h Language and Literature, 2h Social Studies

Cycle 4 - 9H 3h in English language ;
4h Literature and 2h Social Studies with an American teacher
following the American curriculum

In addition to the Diplôme National du Brevet (National Diploma), students will take two oral exams in Literature and Social Studies in order to obtain the DNBI.

students enrolling in grade 7th (5^{ème}) of the American International Section in September 2019 will take the OIB in 2022 which grants them access to Higher education in France, USA and Canada.

Access limited : **24 places per level**

REQUIREMENTS

- WHO ?**
- Students who are fluent in both English and French
 - Students who show intellectual curiosity for the English and French languages and this related cultures
 - Students who are capable of coping with additional classes and who are willing to get involved in ambitious projects.

HOW ? 1- Apply by completing the **ONLINE FORM** (on per student) and add an « **Appraisal Form** » filled by the teacher of your child (for the current school year).

2- Pay the required application fee :

* 30 000 fcfa per student (test on-site)

* 40 000 fcfa per student (distance testing only for CM1 et 6^{ème})

Please note that the application fee is non-refundable.
Should your child pass the tests, a supplement to the standard tuition fee will be applied.
